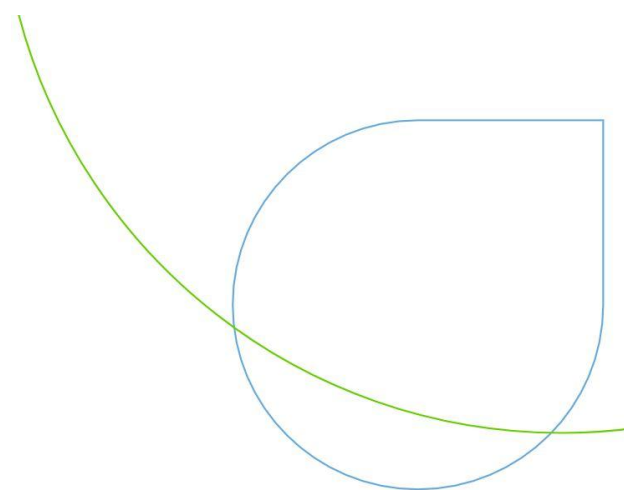

The Solvent Emission Directive (EU Directive 1999/13/EC) limits emissions of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs). This directive defines a VOC as any organic compound having a vapour pressure of 0.01 kPa or more at + 293.15 K (+ 20 °C). Vapour pressure of Nessol 40E at + 20 °C is > 0.01 kPa, measured.

Nessol 40E includes proved emulsifiable additive. The product forms emulsion with water.

The usage is not recommended below -10 °C. If the product has been stored below -10 °C, it must be heated and mixed well before usage.

The product will comply with the specification according to the procedures described in ISO 4259.
